I would like to thank all club executives and coaches who help to make the competition run smoothly and successfully each and every week.

A special thank you to Jeannie for putting in the scores every week.

In 2025, the organisation of the competition will run the same, however after 5 rounds of competition we will hold another convenor meeting for appeals for regrading. After this meeting there will be no further changes in the competition draws. As I found in 2024 clubs and teams wanting to be regraded after 5 rounds which makes it difficult for all divisions to be fair and have an equal competition leading into the final series.

Some suggestions for 2025-

- To host a grading day the week before the competition starts to assist with grading especially in the junior and Intermediate divisions as it can be hard to know before games start where to play a team.
- To review the dual registration process as this was brought into support the smaller clubs and clubs during COVID periods however this in recent years has impacted teams positions and placements in final series.
- **How do we want this rule to look in 2025?**
- The import rule has been changed to include 11-15 year old rep players in both development and representative teams.

- We are all volunteers
- We are looking to make fair and equal competition where all players have the chance to learn, grow and develop as netballers.
- We are looking to place teams in competition where they can be challenged especially those with representative players
- Please remember to place a team in the higher division if they were premiers in 2024.
