



## **Associate Artist - Liz Clifford**

Liz Clifford is an East Hampshire-based artist working in a rural context. Her work is predominantly three dimensional and she uses daily walking as a starting point for observing the landscape and collecting materials. She manipulates the detritus of agri-business and recreation to highlight issues of pollution and slow violence whilst aiming at a sustainable practice through the use of recycled materials.

She studied Fine Art and Education at the University of Cambridge in the 1980's and went on to combine a career as a teacher with that of a practising artist in London, where she was a member of Barbican Arts Group Studios.

She moved to Hampshire in the late nineties and continued to exhibit her work alongside raising a family and maintaining an active interest in art education, both in and beyond the classroom.

In 2021 she completed her MA in Fine Art at the University for the Creative Arts, Farnham.
