Bloom & Worship Women's Group Join us Sat, April 18th for a potluck while we discuss the opportunities to be involved in Epiphany and our surrounding community.

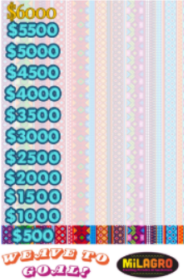
