Faith Formation Fall Kickoff is looking for volunteers! We'll have fun, food & games for the whole family after service on Aug 9th. More info to come!

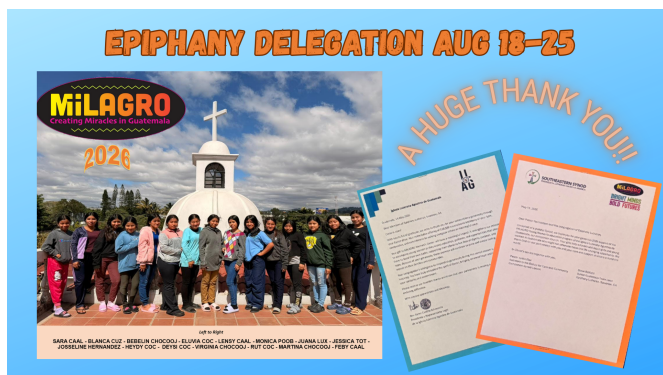
Serving & Giving
