


Welcome Visitors!

Worship

Epiphany is first and foremost a worshipping community. We give thanks to God for all we have been given and seek to build community with all people uniting our gifts of talent and treasure to be the hands and feet of Christ in the world today.

We offer two services each Sunday and a community "Café Worship" on Wednesdays. All services celebrate Holy Communion for all. Our Sunday services are identical in liturgy and offer a blended (contemporary and traditional) musical format.

We welcome all to participate in worship through spoken word and song. We would love to see you in the future as we celebrate God's gifts to us.

Bible Studies

We have a number of Bible Studies throughout the week where you can grown in faith and community. We have your traditional in-between services Sunday morning Bible Study at 10am on the lower level, an in person study at church on Wednesdays at 10am, an online study via Google Meet on Thursdays at 10am (text us for the link 770.831.1966) and for the early birds Friday morning, 6:30am at the Suwanee IHOP. Not only are these great opportunities to grow in your Biblical knowledge, some tremendous relationships have grown out of these groups. At Epiphany we really care about you!

First Fruits Ministry

As a congregation, Epiphany practices "first Fruits" giving outside our doors from our General Fund offering. These offerings support our First Fruit Partners in Ministry: ELCA Southeast Synod, Iglesia Luterana Agustina de Guatemala (ILAG) and the associated Young Women's Education Center MILAGRO, and the Duluth High School Care Closet. Pub Theology

Join us for a monthly gathering where we ask the tough questions, learn from one another, and discuss topics that some churches are scared to approach. We (usually) meet on the first Thursday of the month (Jan 8 this year) at 7pm in the church's cafe. Bring your favorite beverage and join us as we grow in faith and community. This is a great event to invite someone to and for folks who are new to the church and looking to meet new people.

Community

Serving

At Epiphany we seek to live out our faith by serving our neighbors. We serve locally in partnership with Duluth High School and their Care Closet. The Care Closet is a resource for students and their families who may be enduring financial hardship. The Closet provides food, clothing, and whatever a student may need. This is a new partnership for us and we are very thankful for the opportunity to make a difference in our own backyard. We serve internationally with the Lutheran Church in Guatemala (ILAG). We share this partnership with our synod (Southeastern - ELCA) along with other synods and churches across the country. In addition to financially supporting ILAG (see "First Fruits Ministry") we travel to Guatemala annually, usually in August. If you'd like more info on our next trip text us at 770.831.1966. Youth Ministry

There are lots of fun and engaging activities for kids here at Epiphany. For preschool and elementary age children we have Sunday Faith Formation (Sunday School), as well as Stepping Stone events where kids can learn about basic parts of the Christian faith, including Baptism and Holy Communion, through activities like games and crafts. Also, join us for Vacation Bible School at the end of June next year!

For our middle school youth, we have our Confirmation ministry where kids learn more in depth about their faith and their calling as followers of Jesus. Both middle school and high school students have opportunities to go on lifegiving retreats with fellow youth in our area where they can form friendships that can last a lifetime. Men's and Women's Groups

At Epiphany we deeply believe in the power of community. Our women's and men's groups meet (usually) monthly. Sometimes we meet right after church and sometimes we meet on a Monday evening.
