THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Friends, in today's Gospel passage from Matthew, Jesus speaks bluntly to his apostles about the cost of discipleship. Renouncing all goods, including family and material possessions.

Those are challenging words. Is Jesus saying that we should not love our family? Certainly not. Rather, he is using dramatic language to make a teaching point: those who are called to be his disciples must place him at the center of their lives. Love for Christ becomes our first love, the compass that guides every other relationship.

This commitment is not merely emotional. It is expressed in the willingness to take up our cross and follow him. "Whoever loses his life for my sake will find it." The Cross becomes the measure of discipleship. Whenever we choose generosity over selfishness, forgiveness over resentment, or faith over fear, we participate in the life of Christ. Even our sufferings, united to his, become a pathway to deeper communion with God.

Does this mean that following Jesus is simply a life of sacrifice? On the surface, it may seem that way. Yet today's Gospel reveals another side of discipleship: trust in God's providence and therefore the experience of spiritual joy.

Remember to pray for and join us in our St. Regis Cup 2026. Games begin this weekend and will continue all Sundays of July except July 19 due to the Final World Cup. Check our social media for more information.

THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Amigos, en el pasaje evangélico de hoy de Mateo, Jesús habla con franqueza a sus apóstoles sobre el coste del discipulado. Renunciando a todos los bienes, incluidos los bienes familiares y materiales.

Son palabras desafiantes. ¿Está Jesús diciendo que no debemos amar a nuestra familia? Desde luego que no. Más bien, utiliza un lenguaje dramático para hacer un punto de enseñanza: quienes son llamados a ser sus discípulos deben situarle en el centro de sus vidas. El amor por Cristo se convierte en nuestro primer amor, la brújula que guía todas las demás relaciones.

Este compromiso no es solo emocional. Se expresa en la disposición a tomar nuestra cruz y seguirle. "Quien pierda la vida por mí la encontrará." La Cruz se convierte en la medida del discipulado. Siempre que elegimos la generosidad sobre el egoísmo, el perdón sobre el resentimiento, o la fe sobre el miedo, participamos en la vida de Cristo. Incluso nuestros sufrimientos, unidos al suyo, se convierten en un camino hacia una comunión más profunda con Dios.

¿Significa esto que seguir a Jesús es simplemente una vida de sacrificio? A simple vista, puede parecer así. Sin embargo, el Evangelio de hoy revela otra faceta del discipulado: la confianza en la providencia de Dios y, por tanto, en la experiencia de la alegría espiritual.

Recuerda orar por nosotros y unirte a nosotros en nuestra Copa St. Regis 2026. Los partidos comienzan este fin de semana y continuarán todos los domingos de julio excepto el 19 de julio debido a la Copa Mundial Final. Consulta nuestras redes sociales para más información.
