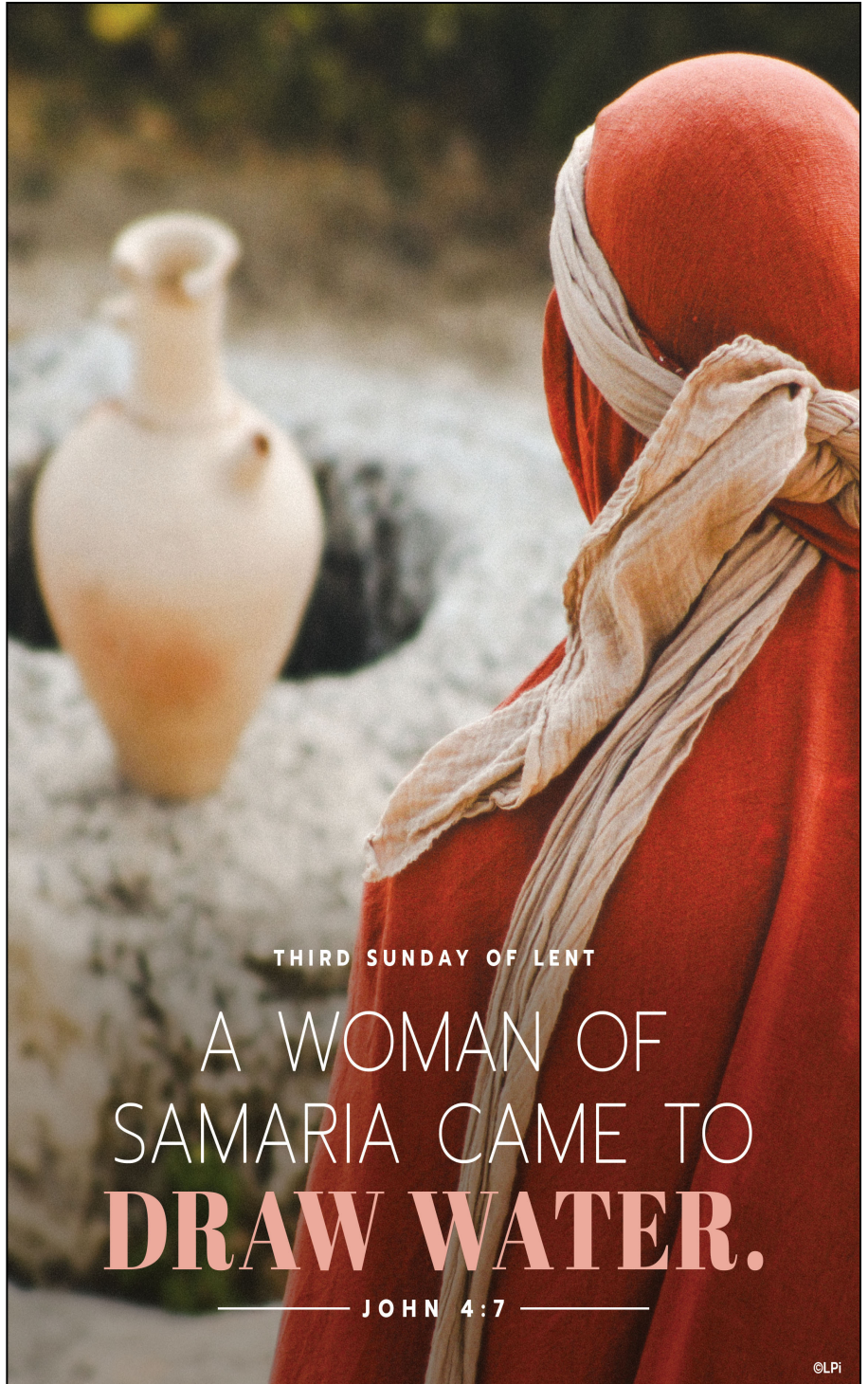

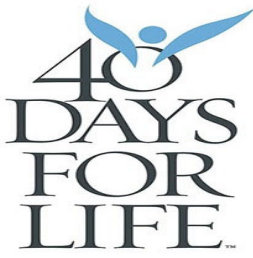

## SACRED HEART TESTIMONIAL

My parents always had a picture of the Sacred Heart of Jesus in our home. When I was old enough to move out that is the only thing I asked my parents if I could take it with me. It hung in my home everywhere I moved my whole life. It is now hanging in the Feed Your Faith room in the MEC because I have anew one in my home.

Ten years ago or so when Fr. Fitzpatrick started Feed Your Faith at Our Lady of Lourdes, he began the evening with Benediction and Devotions to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. He then followed that with dinner and a video. The picture we used in the church every week for Benediction and Devotions was a painting Fr. Fitzpatrick had commissioned an artist to paint of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. It took Father months to pay it off and was breathtakingly beautiful. Mother Julia and I took a photo of that painting and she had it blown up and framed. When the Sisters in Jesus the Lord moved Sister Damiana gave me that picture. It is huge and hangs on our bedroom wall by our bed. We kneel down before it together every night to say our night prayers and touch His Heart before we go to sleep.

Home is not “home” for me without a picture of The Sacred Heart of Jesus. It reminds me He is always there with His heart open and burning with love for us. Not only me, but our whole Feed Your Faith group is devoted to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We say the same Devotions we said at Lourdes every Monday at Feed Your Faith. Even the people who can’t stay for the video won’t leave until after we say our Devotions. After daily Mass, too, we end every Rosary with, “Sacred Heart of Jesus have mercy on us.” —Connie Wood
