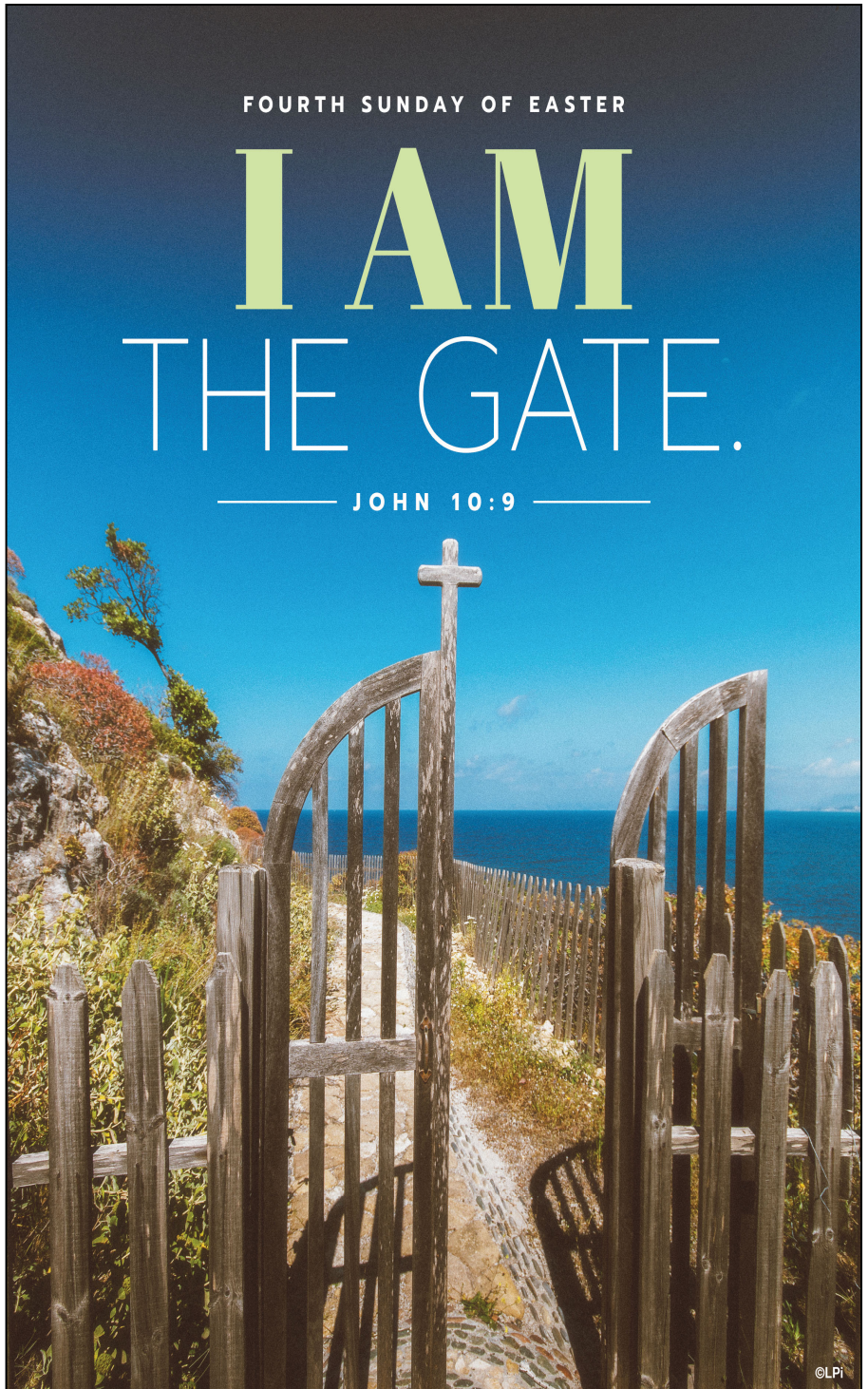

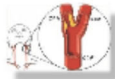

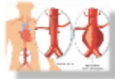

- If you are taking medication, continue to take it.

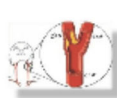

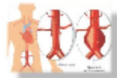

SACRED HEART TESTIMONIAL

As we prepare to consecrate ourselves to Jesus's Sacred Heart this June, I wanted to share a story of a time that Jesus's heart of love met me and encountered me. A few years ago, I was really struggling as a mom of young kids, experiencing self-doubts, exhaustion, and depression. I was honest with the Lord and cried out to him for help and healing. Then one evening, as I was sitting on the side of my bed praying, I closed my eyes and saw Jesus smiling at me. He said, "Follow me." At that point, I expected him to turn around and walk away, and I would have to run after Him to keep up. For a brief moment I thought, "I don't think I can, Lord." But then He surprised me. He walked toward me and carefully took my hand in His. And I realized that this is how I follow Him. I don't have to run to keep up, I just need to know of His presence and His hand in mine. He is right here, walking with me and guiding me gently and with care. After that experience, I have continued to struggle and there continue to be trials in life - but He provides abundant grace, comfort, and joy. The image of His Sacred Heart reminds us that He never lets us struggle alone - His heart is encircled with thorns and pierced for our sins. His burning love is the fuel that keeps me going.
