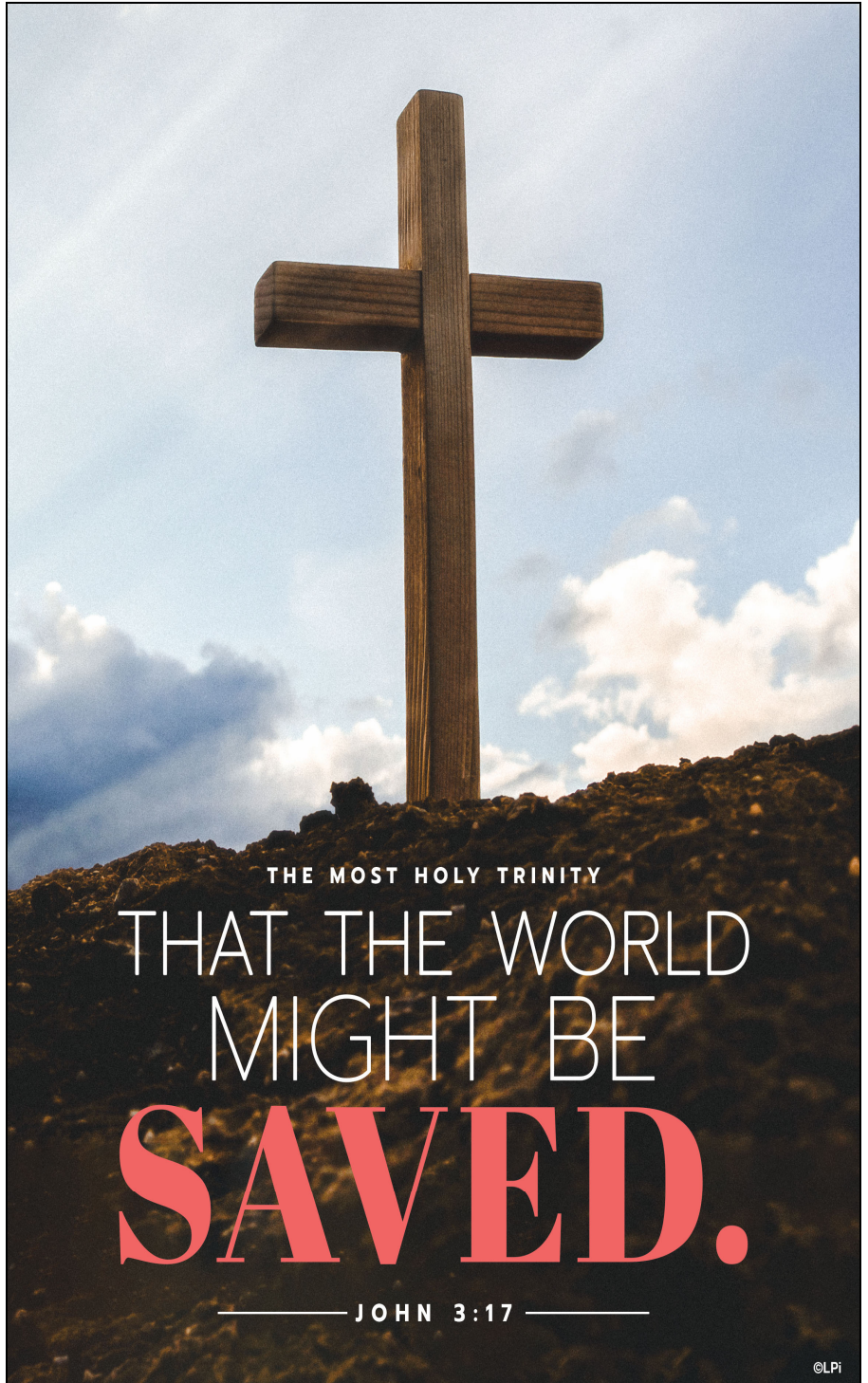

SACRED HEART HOLY HOUR

The adoration hour that we normally have on Wednesday evenings from 6 to 7pm will be very special on **June 10**. It will be a bilingual service with readings and music related to the Sacred Heart consecration for that following weekend. Parishioners are encouraged to bring Sacred Heart images/statues from home to have them blessed. These can be “enthroned” in your homes (see the K of C Pilgrim Icon website for enthronement instructions and prayers). Confessions will be offered during the Holy Hour as usual.

ENTHTONING JESUS IN YOUR HOME

Through the enthronement ceremony, families recognize Christ’s rule over their lives. They do this by placing an image of his Sacred Heart in a place of honor in their homes, renewing their commitment to be faithful disciples, and consecrating themselves to His Sacred Heart. Bring your Sacred Heart image to the Holy Hour (6-7pm) on **June 10** and have it blessed or bring them to Fr. Emmanuel for a blessing at another time. Then go to the K of C Pilgrim Icon website for instructions on the enthronement ceremony.

SACRED HEART TRAVELING ICON

If you would like to honor Jesus and His Sacred Heart, but do not have a sacred heart image, you can obtain the St. Regis traveling icon image for your home for a week. This beautiful image of the Scared Heart of Jesus was painted by and is made available by a St. Regis parishioner. THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Friends, today we celebrate the Most Holy Trinity, the revelation of the mystery of God’s inner life. This mystery will remain for all of us as long as we live in this world, even though the veil which covers it is lifted ever so little.

Our Bible assures us that not only is our God a personal God, but God exists as three Persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, while remaining one God. Although we cannot even begin to give a logical explanation for this, our faith enables us in some small measure to experience the presence of God. How this can happen is stated by St Augustine in a most beautiful passage from his “Confessions” (p. 211). “What do I love when I love my God?” he asks. Then he continues; “Not material beauty or beauty of a temporal order; not the brilliance of earthly light, so welcome to our eyes; not the sweet melody of harmony and song; not the fragrance of flowers, perfumes and spices; not manna or honey; not limbs such as the body delights to embrace. It is not these that I love when I love my God. And yet, when I love him, it is true that I love a light of a certain kind, a voice, a perfume, a food, an embrace; but they are of the kind that I love in my inner self.” “So tell me something of my God,” he asks. And loud and clear they answered, “God is he who made us.”

With all the saints, and the angels, and all Catholics in the world we adore The Holy Trinity as we say: Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Finally, Great News! Bishop Johnston has appointed newly ordained Deacon Xavier Schmidt to serve at St Regis during breaks and time available as he finishes up his last year of Theological studies before his priesthood ordination. More info about Dcn. Xavier is coming soon. Please pray for him and when you see him, welcome him.

THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL

Amigos, hoy celebramos la Santísima Trinidad, la revelación del misterio de la vida interior de Dios. Este misterio permanecerá para todos nosotros mientras vivamos en este mundo, aunque el velo que lo cubre se levante muy poco.

Nuestra Biblia nos asegura que no solo nuestro Dios es un Dios personal, sino que Dios existe como tres personas, Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo, sin perder la vida como un solo Dios. Aunque ni siquiera podemos empezar a dar una explicación lógica para esto, nuestra fe nos permite, en cierta medida, experimentar la presencia de Dios. Cómo esto puede ocurrir lo expone San Agustín en un pasaje muy hermoso de sus "Confesiones" (p. 211). "¿Qué amo cuando amo a mi Dios?" pregunta. Luego continúa; "No belleza material ni belleza de orden temporal; no el resplandor de la luz terrenal, así que bienvenidos a nuestros ojos; no la dulce melodía de la armonía y la canción; no la fragancia de flores, perfumes y especias; no maná ni miel; no extremidades como el cuerpo disfruta abrazar. No son estos los que amo cuando amo a mi Dios. Y sin embargo, cuando le amo, es cierto que amo una luz de cierto tipo, una voz, un perfume, una comida, un abrazo; pero son del tipo que amo en mi interior." "Así que dime algo de mi Dios", pregunta. Y respondieron alto y claro: "Dios es el que nos hizo."

Con todos los santos, los ángeles y todos los católicos del mundo adoramos la Santísima Trinidad como decimos: Gloria al Padre, al Hijo y al Espíritu Santo: Como fue al principio, es ahora y siempre será, mundo sin fin. Amén. Por último, ¡buenas noticias! El obispo Johnston ha nombrado al recién ordenado diácono Xavier Schmidt para servir en St Regis durante los descansos y el tiempo disponible, mientras termina su último año de estudios teológicos antes de su ordenación sacerdotal.
