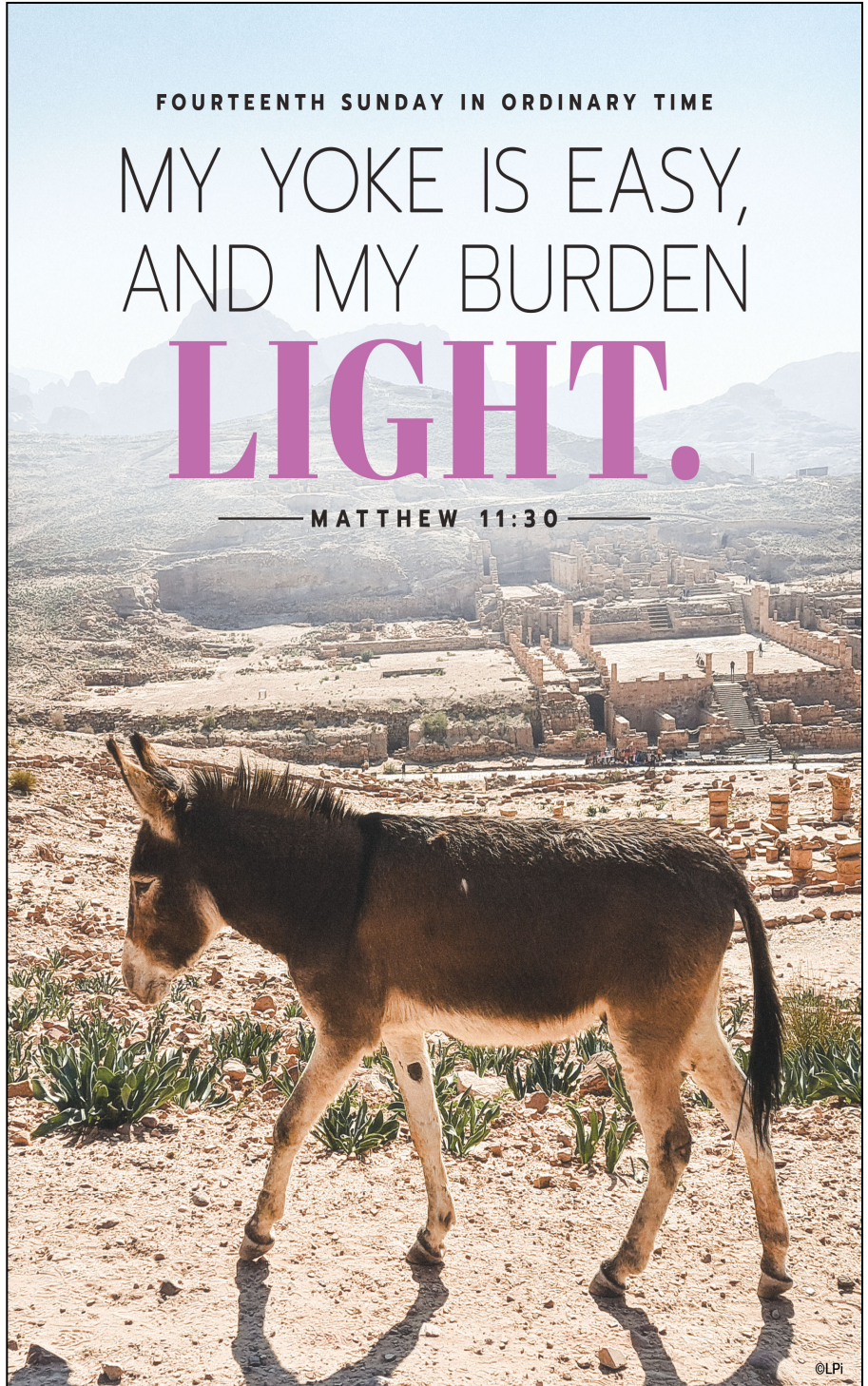

**THOUGHTS FROM FR. EMMANUEL**

Friends,  
In today's Gospel, Jesus praises God for what he has revealed to the little ones, but what is not known to the wise and the learned. Think of how often in the Gospels the scribes and Pharisees lord their knowledge and their wisdom over others, but who fail to learn from Jesus, while the tax collectors and sinners and his group of faithful disciples are able to open their hearts to his message and his proclamation of God's kingdom.

Jesus' message that God's mysteries are hidden from the wise and the learned, refers to the spiritual pride we can have when we think that we rely entirely on our own strength and our own capabilities. This creates the burdens that are too much to bear. Jesus tells us to take his yoke upon us and to learn from him. In the ancient world, a yoke was a wooden beam that was placed over the necks to two animals to allow them to pull a heavy plow or wagon. When Jesus invites us to place ourselves in his yoke, he invites us to be yoked together with him, not to be pulling ourselves through life by ourselves. This is a great invitation to recognize that Jesus is with us every step away, telling us that we will not have to go through our trials and our struggles alone, that He our Savior is with us.
