Think about God's provision of gold, silver, and linen in 11:2 and 12:35. Now skip forward in Exodus to 25:1-8. How do you see God providing for the people to know (yada) Him more personally?

How important do you think it is to God that you know Him in personal relationship, not just in intellectual acceptance?

How might the reaction of the Egyptians, to their request for gold and silver, have formed the people's knowledge of YHWH?

How is God's personally showing up in the tenth plague different from the other plagues? Is this foreshadowing of Rev 20:11-15?

Verses 6-7 indicate that there will be a difference between Israel and Egypt. How does this change the status of the Egyptians who "fear the word of God"?

How is verse 8 a foreshadowing and probably the source of Paul's statement in Phil 2:9-11 and Rev 20:11-15?
