Weekly Memory Verse: "All of us like sheep have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; but YHWH has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him" Isaiah 53:6

How scandalous is it that God came to earth as a man. Look up what Islam teaches about such an act. What does it mean to you that "God humbled himself" to become a man?

Read Isaiah 6:1 and then 52:13. How do these descriptions help you to understand the true nature of the Messiah?

Read the promises of God to His bride in Exodus 6:6-8. How does Isaiah see and redefine the outstretched arm of God in 53:1-3?

How does the tender shoot of verse 2 growing up before YHWH describe the early life of Jesus on the earth?

Read verse 4 and comment on the following "The greatest tragedy of the world is not that the Servant suffered, it is that so many did not recognize Him or esteem Him".

Read verse 5 out loud replacing the word "our" with "my". Does personalizing this statement change how you feel about it?

Memorize verse 6. It is the Gospel boiled down to one sentence.
