Weekly Memory Verse: "But let justice roll down like waters and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream." Amos 5:24

Read Amos Chapter 3. What did it look like then and what does it look like now when God's people ignore God's purpose and turn to living like the rest of the world? How does this speak to Micah 6:8?

Read Amos Chapter 4. How does God try to get our attention in ever increasing ways (from a gentle nudge to fierce discipline) to prevent the kind of destruction that happened to Israel? Is God nudging you in some area of your life?

Read Amos Chapter 5. God calls the people of Israel to "seek the Lord that you may live". Read Deut 30:19. How do these passages compare?

Read verses 21 -24. Now read Isaiah 29:13; Ezekiel 33:1; Matthew 15:7-9. What does your worship look like?

Read Amos Chapter 6. How is God's justice (Mishpat) meted out when in 40 years 10 tribes (northern kingdom) is swallowed up in Assyria never to return?

What does it look like to live a life that demonstrates what it looks like to live in a Kingdom where Jesus is King?
