## **GOSPEL REFLECTION**

There are very few prayers in the Gospels as honest and as human as this one from the apostles: "Increase our faith!" It's not a theological question. It's not an argument. It's a cry of the heart. These are not abstract men in a dusty storybook. These are real disciples who have been walking with Jesus listening, learning, and struggling. They've heard His demands: forgive seventy times seven times, carry your cross daily, love your enemies, live not for yourself but for God. And they're overwhelmed.

So they turn to the Lord, as we often do, and say: "Lord, I want to believe, but help me. I want to follow, but it's hard. Please, increase my faith." And Jesus, as always, answers not as we expect, but as we need.

Jesus begins His response with a stunning image: "If you had faith the size of a mustard seed..."

Many of us hear that and feel discouraged: "Is Jesus saying I don't even have *that much* faith?" But listen again. He's not scolding; He's teaching.

The mustard seed was the smallest seed known to His audience. But what matters isn't its size, it's that it *grows*. The point is not how much faith you have, but **what you do with it**. Even a little, when it is real, living, and planted in trust, can do the impossible.

We often think we need *great* faith to do *great* things. But Jesus says it's not about quantity. It's about quality faith that is alive, humble, and surrendered. A mustard seed doesn't try to be an oak tree overnight. It just starts growing where it's planted.

So what is Jesus saying to us? Don't wait until you feel strong. Don't wait until your doubts disappear. Use the faith you have however small it may feel.

Then comes the second part of the Gospel, which at first glance seems harsh or disconnected:
"Who among you would say to your servant, 'Come and

"Who among you would say to your servant, 'Come and sit down at table'? Would you not rather say, 'Prepare my supper...'?" Jesus uses a parable about a servant to drive home a powerful truth: Faith is not just belief. Faith is obedience.

The servant in the story is not praised for doing what he was supposed to do. He doesn't expect a reward; he simply fulfills his duty. Now remember who Jesus is talking to His disciples. He's shaping them, and us, into people who live not for praise, but from purpose. We are not employees in God's company expecting bonuses. We are children in our Father's house, serving out of love. We do not earn God's favor by our faith or works. We serve because He already loves us. This is a countercultural message in our time. We live in an age of entitlement. We want credit, applause, recognition. But Jesus tells us that faith means saying: "I have only done what was my duty."

There is a profound freedom in this teaching. When you stop trying to impress God or anyone else you become free to serve with joy. When you stop asking, "What's in it for me?" you begin to live like Christ, who came not to be served but to serve.

This humility is not low self-esteem. It's not groveling. It's the quiet strength of someone who knows who they are in God, and doesn't need a spotlight to keep going. Saint Teresa of Calcutta used to say: "God has not called me to be successful. He has called me to be faithful." That is the heart of this Gospel. Not power, not recognition, not even results just faithful service, done in love, with whatever faith we have, even a mustard seed's worth.

He invites us to follow not by might, not by applause, but by trust. So today, let's pray with the apostles: "Lord, increase our faith." And let us live it out, one small act of humble love at a time. Amen.
