NARRATIVE

Tuesday
September 03, 2013
Approximately 18:47 Hours

The undersigned was off duty, plain clothes and coaching a youth football practice at the Owens Memorial Park in Williamstown. Owens Memorial Park was open to the public and there were close to one thousand men, women and children in the park. The undersigned observed a large group running through the park and gathering inside one of the two hockey rinks located at the park. Screaming and shouting could be heard as the undersigned began to approach the hockey rink and a scuffle inside the rink ensued. Upon arriving at the hockey rink, the large group began to exit and disperse. The undersigned entered the hockey rink and observed several individuals screaming and shouting obscenities toward each other. The undersigned observed several shoes and flip flops laying on the ground along with several bags/ purses. The undersigned also observed what appeared to be long hair apparently pulled from someone's head laying on the ground.

The undersigned approached a female, who was visibly upset, and attempted to calm her down. The female was screaming and shouting obscenities towards others in the hockey rink and challenging them to fight. The undersigned advised the female that I was a Detective with the Monroe Township Police Department, asked her if she was ok and advised her I was there to help her. The female did not acknowledge the undersigned and continued screaming and shouting obscenities. The undersigned requested the female to identify herself and advised her to calm down. The female still did not acknowledge the undersigned and continued screaming and shouting obscenities. The undersigned advised the female that if she continued to act disorderly, she would be placed under arrest. (This female was later identified as B [REDACTED] L [REDACTED])

The undersigned then approached another female in the hockey rink that was visibly upset. The female was screaming and shouting obscenities toward the female I was speaking with, B [REDACTED] L [REDACTED], and challenging her to fight. I advised this female that I was a Detective with the Monroe Township Police Department, asked her if she was ok and advised her I was there to help her. The female did not acknowledge the undersigned and continued screaming and shouting obscenities toward the female. The undersigned requested the female to identify herself and advised her to calm down. The female still did not acknowledge the undersigned and continued screaming and shouting obscenities. The undersigned advised the female that if she continued to act disorderly, she would be placed under arrest. (This female was later identified as D [REDACTED] K [REDACTED])

The female later identified as B [REDACTED] L [REDACTED] continued screaming and shouting obscenities. The undersigned advised B [REDACTED] L [REDACTED] that she was under arrest. The

undersigned grasped Breanna Loney's right arm and began to escort her toward the exit of the hockey rink. While escorting Breanna Loney toward the exit, the female later identified as Debra Kay continued screaming and shouting obscenities. The undersigned advised Debra Kay that she was under arrest and grasped her left arm and escorted her toward the exit of the hockey rink. The undersigned escorted the two females out of the hockey rink and toward the concession area of the park. While escorting the two females, neither acknowledged the undersigned; however they continued to scream and shout obscenities toward each other and were challenging each other to fight. The undersigned advised the two females to stop acting disorderly due to the small children in the area. Neither female complied. The undersigned arrived at the concession area and advised the two females to face and stand against the concrete building. The undersigned then contacted Gloucester County Communications, via the telephone, and requested assistance from the Monroe Township Police Department. Officers were then dispatched to Owens Memorial Park.

While awaiting for Police arrival, the two females continued to scream and shout obscenities. The two females continually walked around even though the undersigned advised them to remain still and face the concrete wall. Another female, later identified as Nancy Kay (sister of Debra Kay), stood in between the two females and began to antagonize the situation. The undersigned advised the female to disperse and not to interfere with a police investigation or she would also be placed under arrest. The female indicated that she was not leaving. As all three females continued to scream and shout obscenities toward each other, Nancy Kay removed her flip flop and lunged toward Breanna Loney. Nancy Kay attempted to and did in fact strike Breanna Loney in the head with her flip flop. The undersigned grasped Nancy Kay's right arm and instructed her to get on the ground. Nancy Kay refused to get on the ground and the undersigned used force to place Nancy Kay on the ground. The undersigned performed a leg sweep and took Nancy Kay to the ground, placing her face down. Nancy Kay pulled her arms away from the undersigned and attempted to punch the undersigned. Nancy Kay was instructed several times to place her hands behind her back. The undersigned was able to pull Nancy Kay's arms from beneath her and place them behind her back. Nancy Kay continually lifted her legs in an attempt to kick the undersigned while also attempting to pull her arms from the undersigned and roll over. The undersigned continually advised Nancy Kay to stop moving. The undersigned held Nancy Kay's hands together as she continued to pull away from the undersigned.

Ptl. Ryan Borkowski and Ptl. Jody Collins arrived on location and placed Breanna Loney and Debra Kay into custody. Ptl. Borkowski provided the undersigned with a pair of handcuffs. The undersigned handcuffed Nancy Kay and assisted her to her feet. Nancy Kay was then placed into the rear of patrol unit 782 to be transported to the Monroe Township Police Department.

The undersigned advised Ptl. Borkowski and Ptl. Collins of what transpired. The undersigned instructed the Officers that Complaints would be filed and the

The undersigned was approached by Ann Bracarello, a Monroe Township Parks and Recreation employee, who was working as an attendant in the Ownes Memorial Park during this incident. Ms. Bracarello indicated that she video taped a portion of the incident, specifically when N [REDACTED] K [REDACTED] struck B [REDACTED] L [REDACTED] with her flip flop and then resisted arrest. The undersigned requested Ann Bracarello to email the undersigned the video. Ms. Bracarello later emailed the undersigned the video which was placed on a DVD and entered as evidence, marked GW-1.

Juvenile Complaints were filed against the three females and they were charged accordingly.

NARRATIVE

Wednesday, September 4, 2013 @ 1847hrs:


On the aforementioned date and time, I was dispatched to Owen's Park in reference to a fight. Gloucester County Dispatch further advised me that Det. Wolfe was intervening in this fight while he was off duty.

Upon my arrival at the Concession Stand, I observed the following: Det. Wolfe was on the ground restraining a female, later identified as N [redacted] K [redacted] and another female later identified as D [redacted] K [redacted] was standing in the area of Det. Wolfe yelling towards Det. Wolfe and N [redacted]. As I approached Det. Wolfe, he requested handcuffs in order to handcuff N [redacted]. I provided Det. Wolfe with handcuffs. At this time, Det. Wolfe advised me that the female who was yelling, D [redacted] K [redacted], was also under arrest. I advised D [redacted] that she was under arrest, however, she did not respond and continued to yell towards Det. Wolfe and N [redacted]. Based on her uncooperative behavior I handcuffed D [redacted] and placed her in the rear of Ptl. Collins' vehicle. After doing this, Det. Wolfe pointed to another female, later identified as B [redacted] L [redacted], and advised me that she too was involved in the fight and she was under arrest. I approached B [redacted] and advised her that she was under arrest. B [redacted] was cooperative and polite towards me. She was not handcuffed and placed in the rear of my patrol vehicle.

Ptl. Collins advised me that D [redacted] advised him that she has asthma and was possibly having asthma attack. Therefore, an ambulance was dispatched to the scene. As we sorted this incident out, the mother of B [redacted] (Constance J. Loney) arrived on location. In addition, the guardian of both D [redacted] and N [redacted] (Beatrice Rawls) arrived on location. Once the squad arrived on location, they treated D [redacted], however, Beatrice signed a refusal form which stated that D [redacted] was not going to be transported by Monroe Twp. Ambulance squad to the hospital.

After sorting the situation out and [redacted] being treated by Monroe Twp. Ambulance squad, all three juvenile females were transported to Headquarters for processing. All three juvenile females were logged into the Juvenile Admission Log.

Once the processing was completed, D [redacted] and N [redacted] were released to their guardian, Beatrice Rawls and B [redacted] was released to her mother, Constance J. Loney. All the necessary paperwork was completed for this release and is attached physically to Det. Wolfe's report. Nothing further at this time.
