Developed by MUSIC CARE by ROOM 217™, a leader in music care education, MUSIC CARE CERTIFY empowers caregivers with tools, training, and resources to bring a music care approach into living and dying.

PROGRAM GOAL

To establish, integrate and evaluate music within HPC to improve quality of life and care outcomes for everyone

STEP 5 - SUBMIT VALIDATION DOCUMENTATION

Q: Who can join the site team?

Nurses, PSWs, Social Workers, Administrators, Family members, Chaplains, Volunteers, Music therapist

Q: When does the program start?

Cohorts begin in January, April and September

Q: What does the site team lead do?

Tracks progress and submits validation documentation through the music care portal

Q: What does the music care facilitator do?

Provides coaching, offers resources, supports planning and ensures successful certification


