These units are more spacious for stroller and wheel chair accessibility, include handrails, and feature ground-level entry to ensure inclusivity at your event.

4. Handwashing Stations

Proper hygiene and sanitation is crucial, especially when food is involved. **Handwashing stations** can be rented alongside any portable toilet rental to help guests, children and/or workers maintain cleanliness.

Choosing The Right Portable Toilet Rental

Selecting the right portable toilet depends on several factors, including the type of event, number of attendees, and duration of use. Here are some key considerations:

-Event Type

Weddings, festivals, and construction sites all have different requirements. For formal events, a luxury restroom trailer is best, while standard construction site porta potties work well for job sites.

-Event Guest Count

The general rule of thumb is one porta potty per 25 people for a four-hour event. If alcohol will be served at the event, it is recommended to multiply the number of attendees by 20 percent in order to prevent long lines. -Construction Site Employee Count

The most precise estimates on the number of construction site portable toilets can be found [here](#) by using our portable toilet calculator. A general rule for construction portable restrooms is:

- One porta potty per 15-20 workers for a 40-hour workweek for construction sites.

- For sites with overtime shifts or 24-hour operations, more portable toilets or frequent servicing may be required to maintain hygiene and efficiency.

Your portable sanitation service provider can walk you through selecting the appropriate number of construction site porta potties for your project.

-Duration

For multi-day events, more frequent servicing will be necessary to maintain clean portable toilets.

-Weather

Heat and Sun Exposure: In the summer months, high temperatures can cause portable toilets to become hot and uncomfortable. Heat accelerates the breakdown of waste, which can lead to stronger odors if not managed properly.

Solutions: Use deodorizing and fragrance additives in the holding tank. Increase servicing frequency. Rent luxury restroom trailers with air conditioning. Place units in shaded areas when possible.

Freezing Temperatures: Cold weather brings a different set of issues. Waste and water inside the tanks can freeze, making the units unusable and potentially damaging the internal systems.

Solutions: Add non-toxic antifreeze to holding tanks. Use heated luxury restroom trailers. Position units in sun-exposed areas during the day.

Heavy Rain and Flooding: Rain can cause muddy conditions, making portable toilets difficult to access and increasing the risk of the portable toilet tipping over or sinking into soft ground. It can also lead to unsanitary conditions if water enters the toilet area.

Solutions: Secure portable toilets on level, well-drained ground. Use gravel or wooden platforms to keep portable toilets elevated. Stake or tie down units to prevent movement.

Wind and Storms: Strong winds can knock over unsecured porta potties, creating both a mess and a safety hazard. Storms can also cause damage to doors, vents, and roofs of the porta potties.

Solutions: Anchor portable toilets securely, especially in open areas. Use heavier models or add ballast to the base. Monitor weather and reposition or remove portable toilets during extreme weather alerts.

Snow and Ice: In snow-prone areas, access to portable toilets can be blocked, and surfaces become slippery, increasing the risk of accidents. Ice can also interfere with door mechanisms and ventilation.

Solutions: Clear snow regularly from around the portable toilet. Add slip-resistant mats or platforms. Apply lubricants to door hinges and locks to prevent freezing.

-Placement

Portable toilets should be easily accessible but not intrusive to the event layout. Consider portable toilet placement in proximity to food areas, entrances, and pathways.

- Cluster portable toilets within 150–200 feet of high-traffic zones.
- Understand setbacks from buildings and property lines
- Place porta potties near food areas, seating, or break zones.
- Avoid tight walkways, narrow spaces, or hidden corners
- Keep access paths clear and well-lit, especially at night.
- Allow for portable toilet service truck access
- Ensure proper signage for the portable toilet locations
