Holy Thursday, April 6th

Lent ends quietly Thursday afternoon. In the evening, the Church enters the Triduum which ends on Sunday evening.

7:30 p.m. — Mass of the Lord's Supper
This is the only Mass of the day.
(choir, incense)

- Blessed sacred oils brought forward for the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Anointing of the Sick.
- Washing of feet as Jesus did, commemorating the commandment to love and serve one another.
- Procession to the parish hall with the Body of Christ: adoration of the Blessed Sacrament until Midnight.

Jesus asks: "Could you not watch a little while with me?"

Good Friday, April 7th

A day of fast and abstinence: one full meal and no meat.
We gather in silence to continue the Triduum.

12 Noon – Solemn Liturgy of the Lord's Passion
(choir)

- Begins with us on our knees praying.
- Passion proclaimed by readers
- Solemn Veneration of the Cross
- Communion

2 p.m. Stations of the Cross

7:30 p.m. - Solemn Liturgy of the Lord's Passion
(cantor)

(No Mass this day. The hosts we receive were consecrated in the liturgy of Holy Thursday.)

12 p.m. to 3 p.m. were the hours Jesus was on the Cross.
If possible, make these hours special. Try to quiet your life: leave the shopping, TV and movies for another day. Whenever you can, take time for prayer, perhaps a quiet walk, etc...

The Church will be open for prayer.

Easter Vigil, April 8th

We gather again in silence to continue the Triduum.

8 p.m. — Easter Vigil
(choir, incense)

- Begins outside in darkness
- Blessing of the New Fire, lighting of the Easter (Paschal) Candle
- Easter Proclamation (The Exultet — “Rejoice...”)
- History of Salvation Old Testament readings
- Celebrating Sacraments of Initiation
 - Baptisms
 - Profession of Faith
 - Confirmation
- Liturgy of the Eucharist
- Reception in Parish hall after Mass, to celebrate with the new members of the Catholic Church.

Easter Sunday, April 9th

The Triduum ends Sunday evening.

(Overflow video feed in the Hall)

8 a.m. (cantors)

10 a.m. (choir, incense, overflow in the Parish Hall)

12 p.m. (choir, incense, overflow in the Parish Hall)
