beat/pulse

beat music

melody

accompaniment

tempo

the steady heartbeat of the music

a style of music with a **strong beat on each beat** which the Beatles were famous for playing

the combination of pitch and rhythm to create a tune

music played that supports the main melody

part of a song which has **different words** but the **same tune** each time it appears

part of a song which is usually repeated after each verse

a percussion instrument that does **not play pitch**

a percussion instrument that **plays pitch**

grouping the beat of the music, for example into groups of 2s, 3s or 4s

the **speed** of a piece of music
