Indian classical music which comes from the Northern region of India

the **rhythm** in Hindustani music that is played in **repeated cycles**


a particular tala played over 16 beats

a rhythmic piece of music played on the tablā

the melodic framework upon which a piece of Hindustani music is based

one or more notes played repeatedly, over which other instruments play


to invent music on the spot. In the case of Hindustani classical music improvisation is based around the tala and the raga
