The members of the Group also co-ordinate collaborative work that is needed to support these objectives.



When do we meet?

The Group normally meets biannually in the Spring and Autumn with meetings being sponsored by the member companies. Joint meetings are also held in collaboration with other scientific groups

The Group represents the general interests of the UK industrial reproductive laboratories in discussions with other scientific groups, manufacturers, suppliers and regulatory authorities.
