SUMMARY

With the cessation of hostilities in the European Theatre on 8 May 1945 the USAAF started the re-deployment of the Bombers from the UK to the US and onwards to the Pacific Theatre of Operations. Known as 'Happy Valley' to the arriving/departing crews, Valley was chosen and operated by the European Division of the Air Transport Command. The inbound aircraft had undergone inspections at their homebases with emphasis on life rafts, life belts and other emergency equipment and were loaded in accordance with weight/balance manuals. They carried 10 crew and 10 passengers plus mail for the US. On arrival the crews were taken to the terminal and given hot drinks and doughnuts and were able to convert UK Sterling to American Dollars. The Pilots, Co-pilots, Navigators and Radio Operators were woken at around 04:30 and given an hour-long briefing covering the various stopover and emergency airfields on their homeward journey. Handbooks and charts were handed out for the route as well. Routing would be either via Iceland [Meeks Field] or the Azores [Lagens] The number of combat missions flown by each aircraft returning to the US are noted in brackets.

Although the daily headers show the numbers involved with the RZI flights only confirmed movements have been incorporated as some aircraft routed home to the USA via Prestwick.

At 23:10 RAF Church Fenton informed Valley that they had diverted a Mosquito to Valley. Contact was made and the aircraft homed to Valley. It then flew out to sea to carry out a cloud break, at 23:24 the aircraft reported at 1,500ft and was instructed to turn port onto a course of 080degs but failed to acknowledge and nothing further was heard. The North West Filter room had a fading plot in sector VH 4989 [10nms SW of Valley]. Searches were also carried out by 1528 BAT Flight on 6.1 but with no results. The crew are commemorated on the Runneymede Memorial.

Scrambled following a Mayday call from a High Ercall based Mosquito at 16:06. The NW Filter room diverted one of the BAT Oxfords to the Great Orme area, a second Oxford was also diverted to the area. At 16:20 the Filter room reported that the aircraft had ditched near Little Orme's Head and Search/Rescue action was being initiated. At 16:47 P/O Sinclair reported that he was circling a dinghy and a minute later another High Ercall Mosquito 'BALSAM56' made the same call. P/O Sinclair led the rescue boat to the dinghy and at 17:05 it was reported the crew had been picked up, sadly one of the crew was dead whilst the

Each aircraft carried 20 [10 combat crew plus 10 groundcrew/non-flying] personnel including crew.


The aircraft were routed back to the US via Meeks Field, Iceland or Lagens, Azores with the destination for 4-engined aircraft being Bradley Filed, Connecticut.



Although undated this is a view which would have been familiar to the American Crews transitting through Valley back to the USA. On the NW dispersal 'natural metal' B-17's can be seen plus a few more on what is now [2025] the Texan flightline. To the left of those there appears to be camouflaged B-24's.

Departed from its base at Polebrook to transit to Valley and the following day to re-deploy to the US [RZI] Whilst approaching Valley in low visibility it requested a course to steer. However, it flew the reciprocal and flew inland towards Dolgellau. After a short while the crew realised the error and turned back towards Valley but struck high ground just below the summit of Craig Cwm Llwyd on the Southern side of the Mawddach Estuary at 10:30. All 10 crew plus 10 passengers were killed. The aircraft was originally assigned to the 422 BS/305 BG but for the journey home to the US it was transferred to the 351 BG on 23.5.45 This crash is sometimes attributed to B-17G 44-6005 but 44-8639 is the correct serial. On 12.9.54 the Valley MRT Section found a silver identification bracelet bearing the inscription 'Howard R Hibbard' and 'Eileen' on the reverse, it was handed over to OC Flying Wing & onward to HQ USAAF UK.




