

At 12:30 a farmer in the vicinity of Llyn Eigiau saw an aircraft flying towards him from the North West. The aircraft appeared to be complete and flying at high speed in a 20deg dive, wings level. It continued on its path at high speed, dived behind a hill and struck a rock face at 1,550ft amsl on the East side of Llyn Eigiau, Snowdonia [OS 115/727646] the pilot was killed instantly. 22 Sqn Whirlwind HAR.2 XJ728 [M/P N P F Hill] was scrambled to this incident with the SMO [Station Medical Officer] from Valley. RAF Valley MRT were also called out. Possibility of a loose article [13inch metal bar used as a fuel tank cap spanner] in the cockpit may have jammed the flying controls.



The Magazine 'Flying Review' for July 1960 has a SAR article. Part of it recounts a Hunter piloted by F/O N R Williams departing from **RAF Valley** and suffering an engine explosion and a fire caption at 35,000ft over the North Sea. He ejected and the seat free-fell mainly through thick cloud to 10,000ft when the chute deployed and the seat fell away. He finally came out of cloud at 100ft and after ditching he managed to get into his dinghy. He then ensured that the homing 'SARAH' beacon was switched on. After 45mins he was picked up by a helicopter from A Flt/275 Sqn at RAF Thornaby [F/L J W Thompson]. The Hunter was home based with 66 Sqn at RAF Linton-on-Ouse. The 66 Sqn ORB mentions the incident but there is no mention of Valley only mention of a cine exercise. The 275 Sqn ORB mentions the rescue taking place off Filey.







The pilot was briefed to do night circuits at Valley, and he was told specifically not to cross the Menai Straits. At 19:01 [night] he took off from Valley and was seen 9 minutes later flying straight and level with navigation lights on at approx. 1500ft. He was flying on the mainland side of the Menai Straits and the engine sounded normal. Less than a minute later a large flash was seen on the top of Mynydd Mawr, Snowdonia [OS 115/539547] The wreckage was found in the early hours of the morning, the pilot was killed instantly. The MRT was also called out and reached the top of the mountain in good time, but the Police and other locals were already in attendance. Funeral held in Holyhead 16.10.56. He was an ex. RAF Transport Command Navigator. No definitive cause could be found for this incident. Shackleton MR.1A WB850:[L-J] 240 Sqn [F/L Williams] was also involved in the SAR effort but did not land.


