Briefed for aerobatics not below 10,000ft. the aircraft took off from Valley at 13:08. After making radio contact with approach nothing else was heard from the aircraft. At approx. 13:20 witnesses described the aircraft as descending from a moderate height in an attitude which suggested that it was out of control and possibly spinning, finishing up in a steep and high speed dive. The pilot was killed. It crashed 100mtrs from Faenol Fawr Farm, Bodelwyddan [OS 116/003764]. The pilot may possibly have been knocked unconscious when the canopy detached [fragments of the canopy including the starboard jettison latch rail were found 880yds from the impact crater] 22 Sqn attended with Whirlwind HAR.2 XJ729 flown by F/S J M M Walker. Funeral held at St Elbod's Church and burial at Holyhead Cemetery on 8.1.57. Cause was determined as a loss of control during an aerobatic manoeuvre.
