

The passenger in the lead aircraft F/L Tyler a QFI with Bristol UAS ejected but sustained 3 factures of the left leg. F/L Mermagen was trapped in the aircraft and was killed on impact. The other aircraft involved XS108 returned to Valley damaged and attempted a wheels up landing but cartwheeled after landing and exploded killing P/O Priest. The third aircraft which was not involved in the mid-air landed safely at RAF Mona.

22 Sqn scrambled 2 aircraft, Whirlwind HAR.10 XJ426 [F/L Scott] which picked up the SMO and a fireman and proceeded to XS108, but the pilot F/O Priest was dead, the helicopter then flew to where F/L Tyler had ejected and joined a CFS helicopter in searching for him. XJ426 flew F/L Tyler to Bangor Hospital. The second 22 Sqn Whirlwind HAR.10 XP352 [F/S Mitchell] joined the search for F/L Mermagen but the SMO later confirmed that the pilot was dead in the wreckage. Other aircraft had joined in the search including an Anson, Shackleton and 2 CFS helicopters. XR950 had crashed near the Summerhill House Playground, Carmel. XS108 wreckage was removed to 60 MU at Dishforth.
