Hydraulic failure in the circuit rendering aircraft uncontrollable. Both Pilots ejected safely. Aircraft crash landed on Rhosneigr Beach relatively intact. Damaged beyond repair and struck off charge 1.9.67. Wreck ended up on the Valley fire dump by 10.8.68. A 22 Sqn Whirlwind HAR.10 XP350 [F/L Ridge] 'PEDRO22' was just returning from a training sortie and was waiting to cross the active runway at Valley when a Gnat was observed doing a touch and go. Once airborne again the Gnat adopted a steep nose-up attitude and turned steeply to port towards the hovering helicopter. F/L Ridge took evasive action and heard the Gnat crew transmit on the radio that they had a 'control restriction' and the aircraft was practically uncontrollable, the crew would endeavour to stay with the aircraft until clear of the airfield and out to sea before ejecting. The helicopter followed the wildly gyrating Gnat then saw both pilots in their parachutes. One pilot landed on the perimeter of the airfield and was seen to walk ok. The other pilot drifted out to sea but landed on the beach, the helicopter landed next to the pilot who was conscious but complaining of leg pains. The Winchman [Sgt Holegate] released the pilot's parachute harness [at this time the Gnat was seen to crash land into the sea 40yds off Rhosneigr beach] and the Navigator [F/L Danieli] secured both legs by using the leg restraint straps as both legs appeared to be broken. Pilot was secured by stretcher and flown to the Valley SSQ. The other pilot was picked up by a CFS Whirlwind carrying out local flying and also flown to the SSQ.
