Sea Vixen made an emergency landing at RAF Valley after a diversion from HMS Eagle which was on its last day of the work up in UK waters before heading to the Mediterranean. On recovery to HMS Eagle the windscreen of the Sea Vixen was covered in salt reducing drastically the forward visibility on final approach to the Carrier. After 2 missed approaches on the 3rd the aircraft veered to the right and the right wing hit a Gannet, Buccaneer & 2 Sea Vixens causing extensive damage. The Observer nearly ejected but the aircraft climbed away from the Carrier and proceeded to divert to Valley. As they raised the gear the aircraft rolled uncontrollably so the gear was lowered again, and the aircraft continued to Valley. The landing there was uneventful, but the Crew were admonished for not declaring an emergency. The last 8 feet of wing was missing, and the aileron was hanging down. The Crew were eventually flown back to the ship by helicopter. 22 Sqn Whirlwind HAR.10 XP361 'RESCUE22' [F/O Haqui] remained airborne until the Sea Vixen had landed. The aircraft was later removed by road. It was next noted at NASU [Naval Aircraft Support Unit] Yeovilton on 25.2.71. It returned to service and eventually found its way to Llanbedr 19.4.73 as part of the drone programme. The pilot was sadly killed later during the Falklands War in Sea Harrier FRS.1 XZ452:007 801 NAS on 6.5.82. The Observer is also quoted as S/Lt B M Clark. [HMS Eagle's complement was:






