#### **SUMMARY**

The main event in 1972 was the 4 FTS temporary move to RAF Fairford whilst RAF Valley's runways & taxiways were re-surfaced. The original plan was 29.4-19.6 but this was extended to 7.7 due to subsoil and culvert problems at Valley.




