These meals are meant for the whole congregation after the Youth Mass as a means of fellowship and a little something to eat. There were many requests for this recipe.

#### **Blueberry Croissant Puff**

3 large croissants, cut up into cubes (about 5 cups)
1 C. Fresh or frozen blueberries OR fruit of choice
1 8 oz. Pkg. Cream cheese, softened

2/3 C. sugar 2 eggs 1 tsp. vanilla 1 C. milk

- 1. Preheat oven to 350.
- 2. Place croissant pieces in bottom of lightly sprayed 9 x 9 pan. Sprinkle with blueberries. (I used cut up frozen peaches for the other one).
- 3. Beat cream cheese, sugar, eggs and vanilla in medium mixing bowl with hand mixer until well blended. Gradually add milk and beat until smooth. Pour evenly over croissant pieces & blueberries. Let stand 20 minutes or refrigerate overnight.
- 4. Bake at 350 for 35-40 minutes or until set in the center and golden brown. You may want to cover with foil the last 10 minutes if it is getting too browned.
- 5. Serve warm. Can sprinkle powdered sugar on top (I did not) This can be doubled for a  $9 \times 13$  pan.

St. Felix /St. Agnes Book Club will be studying the book: "Wisdom of the Psalms" by Peter Kreeft. The first meeting will be on Tuesday, January 28th

from 3:30-4:30 PM at the Hust home on 612 14th Street in Wabasha. We will meet for 7 weeks in participants' homes. Please let Nancy Hust at (651) 764-1218 know if you are interested. The book can be picked up in the Parish Office at the cost of \$5.00. The Psalms are the most popular, most universally loved and used book in the Bible. They are hymns, songs, poems and prayers, both formal (liturgical and communal) and informal (spontaneous, personal, and individual); and this gives them many layers of meaning rather than one. In this work Kreeft shares his personal explorations into the riches of the Psalms, his profound expeditions into this deep ocean of the divinely inspired spiritual water. He focuses on the dozen or so Psalms that are most people's favorites.

We invite you to consider volunteering for one (or more) of the following important roles:


