




Training for **Ushers and Church Cleaners** will be scheduled in the near future.

New ministers will begin serving on the schedule starting in February.


If you have any questions, please contact Deacon John or the Parish Office.

SOCIAL CONCERNS COMMITTEE MEETING

MINUTES

Thursday, January 15, 2026

The meeting opened with a prayer to the Holy Spirit for guidance in 2026 and all its challenges, locally, nationally and globally.

- Regarding a possible series on Catholic Social Teaching it was agreed that there would not be a series, but a single event sometime in the coming year that will include the 7 videos available through the USCCB.
- It was agreed that promoting the Diocesan Synod summary and goals would be most appropriately carried out by the St. Felix Pastoral Council; synod delegates Sandra Allaire and Ron Zeilinger would be available for a future Pastoral Council meeting.
- The major portion of the meeting was given to discerning and deciding on the committee's main concerns and goals for 2026; each member shared from the questionnaire previously distributed to them, rating concerns locally, nationally and globally. A final summary of the 2026 goals will be presented at the February meeting.
- The meeting closed with prayer for the grace to be good Christians and citizens in this difficult time.
