Father Tom Loomis Pastor

Thank you for your patience with my voice last weekend. Thank you to Fr. Russell for helping out at St. Agnes on Sunday morning. Over thirty -two years of priesthood I have been shut down saying Masses only a couple of times. By taking time to recover from my cold it gave me time to reflect on how fragile I am and what a miracle our human bodies really are. I realized that I seldom thank God for my health and ability to do what is needed most of the time. My rest gave me an opportunity to slow down for a bit and realize how many gifts have been poured upon me. Usually, I become a bit ornery when I'm not feeling good. This time I tried not to become so ornery and be comfortable with myself. Not always an easy thing to do. Thanks for your prayers and support.

We hear from Luke's Gospel for this weekend's celebration of the Eucharist. We will begin the Gospel reading with Chapter 1:1-4, then we skip ahead to Chapter 4:14-21. Luke explains how this story about Jesus is true and real. People have seen him and experienced him. Then in chapter 4 we see Jesus in the Temple and he reads from the scroll of Isaiah where he says that this reading is fulfilled in their hearing. What Jesus is saying is that he is the Son of God. The people who hear this are stunned and we know that this is the beginning of his journey to the Cross. Do we hear what Jesus says to us as individuals and as a community. During this week, how might we reflect and pray for the captives, the poor, the blind and oppressed? How do we proclaim Jesus this week?

St. Felix /St. Agnes Book Club will be studying the book: "Wisdom of the Psalms" by Peter Kreeft. The first meeting will be on Tuesday, January 28th

from 3:30-4:30 PM at the Hust home on 612 14th Street in Wabasha. We will meet for 7 weeks in participants' homes. Please let Nancy Hust at (651) 764-1218 know if you are interested. The book can be picked up in the Parish Office at the cost of \$5.00. The Psalms are the most popular, most universally loved and used book in the Bible. They are hymns, songs, poems and prayers, both formal (liturgical and communal) and informal (spontaneous, personal, and individual); and this gives them many layers of meaning rather than one. In this work Kreeft shares his personal explorations into the riches of the Psalms, his profound expeditions into this deep ocean of the divinely inspired spiritual water. He focuses on the dozen or so Psalms that are most people's favorites.

We invite you to consider volunteering for one (or more) of the following important roles:


