Opening Prayer – USCCB: “Advent Prayer to See Jesus in Others”

- A Lenten Series on Catholic Social Teaching is being planned and finalized at the next meeting.
- The Summary of the Diocesan Synod could be a focus of study and implementation in 2026.
- A Pilgrimage of Creation at Hok-Si-La Park is planned for Earth Day, April 22, 2026
- The UN Climate Conference (COP3) held in November was reviewed; the results were less than positive given the absence of the U.S; the earth’s temperature continues to rise; hope resides with global leaders and the youth whose future it is.
