

First, I am excited to announce that we have decided to renew our subscription to FORMED, an online Catholic streaming service sponsored by the Augustine Institute. This platform contains a variety of content for children, adults, and families, ranging from Bible studies and

catechetical materials to a variety of other movies, documentaries, and shows. To sign up, head to formed.org, click "Formed for Parishes," then "Find Your Parish Subscription," type and select "St. Felix" from the options in the search bar, and enter your email to receive your confirmation code and login.



Similarly, continuing on the heels of their success with the "Bible in a Year" and "Catechism in a Year" podcasts, Ascension Press is offering the "Rosary in a Year" podcast in 2025, hosted by Fr. Mark-Mary Ames, CFR. The podcast will explore a variety of theological and spiritual elements of the Rosary, combining Scripture, art, and catechesis

from the Church Fathers with the devotion itself. If you are interested in listening this year, feel free to pick up a QR code flyer in the back of either parish, or find the podcast through Apple Podcasts, Spotify, or YouTube.
