Prayer Ministry

As we have begun a new year, I want to share with you a new ministry we will be starting in our parishes, it will be **Personal Prayer Ministry**. We know prayer has many forms, it can be private or communal. Personal Prayer Ministry will be held following the Masses on some weekends initially. This will be private and confidential prayer which will be for physical, mental or spiritual needs of individuals. It is our hope that as we form a larger prayer team we can offer this prayer after all Masses. Initially it will be offered a couple times a month at our parishes beginning in February. Prayer will be in the Holy Family room or in the Sacristy. After Mass is a great time to pray since we have encountered Jesus in the community, in His word and in the Eucharist. This prayer we believe will foster a growth in community and service. If you are interested in becoming part of this ministry or if you have questions, feel free to contact Fr. Tom or Deacon John. **“A family (church community) that prays together, stays together.”** May we grow in ministry and service as a parish community in 2026.


2nd Week ordinary time

The first reading from Isaiah reminds us that God desires us to be, **a light to the nations, that his salvation may reach to the ends of the earth**. We must remember we are not the light but receive the light through a relationship with Jesus Christ which begins with Baptism. Every time we encounter Christ in prayer, in His Word, or in the Sacraments, we are filled with grace and light. We are called to share the good news of Jesus Christ. As the responsorial psalm says, “Here am I, Lord: I come to do your will.” In the Gospel of John today, John the Baptist reminds of three aspects of who Jesus is. He says Jesus is, the Son of God, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world and the one who will Baptize with the Holy Spirit. We have just finished the Christmas season where we celebrated the Truth that Jesus is the Word made flesh through the Incarnation and is the **Son of the God**. Why did he come? He came to save us by dying on the cross (being the perfect **sacrificial lamb**) offered for our sins. Finally, after His Resurrection and Ascension, he sent the Holy Spirit to fill and guide the Church until he comes again. May we reflect on these truths this coming week.
