

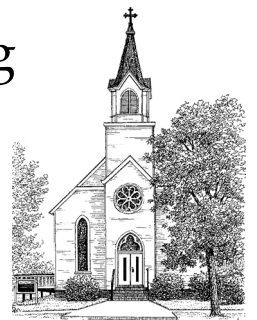

You probably have heard about our upcoming Parish Dinner on Saturday, November 8, following the Youth Mass at 4:30 PM. The purpose of this gathering is for the St. Felix community to share a meal and then share thoughts and hopes for the future of St. Felix parish and school. This will include potential structural updates and addressing spiritual needs.

This weekend we celebrate the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome. It is the Cathedral Church for Rome where Pope Leo the 14th presides. It was established in 325 AD and is considered the mother church for all Catholic's.

The second reading from Corinthians reminds us that Jesus Christ is the foundation of the Church. Through Baptism we become members of His Church (the Body of Christ) and are temples of the Holy Spirit. May the light of the Holy Spirit shine through us.

From the Book of the prophet Ezekial, we hear about the water flowing from the temple (Church). Wherever the water flows it brings abundant life and fruit. This river is a symbolic example of the Holy Spirit flowing and bringing life to God's people and the Church. Where is the Holy Spirit leading St. Felix and St. Agnes?

In the Gospel of John today we see Jesus's anger when the temple is not being used properly. The temple (Church) is established for communal worship and prayer. 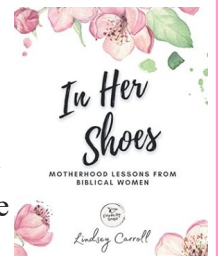
