In January the third-grade students have been busy working on several skills and projects. The children have been practicing their multi plication and division skills. With each multiplication fact family learned, the student earns a piece for a paper Sundae. The students' reading skills are also being challenged this month and into February with the Super Reader Bowl! The third graders are to read 10 books by February 10th, the day after the Super Bowl.
