Bishop Barron has asked all priests to gather at Christ the King Retreat Center in Buffalo, MN. February 8-13. I, along with most priests from the diocese will be attending this retreat. That means there will be no daily Masses here or nearby in this area. In Wisconsin they will be having daily Masses if you wish to attend during the week. This retreat has been happening every other year and used to be during the Lenten Season. I appreciate that we now have this retreat before the Lenten Season to help us prepare for Ash Wednesday and Lent. I'm also looking forward to the retreat to spend time with my brother priests. We do enjoy getting together to pray, learn, and visit together. Please hold all our diocesan priests in your prayers. Thank you.

As we gather this weekend to celebrate the Eucharist, we continue to hear from the Gospel of Matthew 5:13-16. Jesus continues his teaching and his Sermon on the Mount. He speaks to us about living a good life and giving glory to God. When I hear Jesus speak to us like this, his Mother Mary comes to my mind and heart. His teaching today centers on salt and light. If we are salt and light, we bring life to relationships and even to our communities by pointing to Jesus. 
