I am looking forward to my first Grumpy Old Men weekend. I was out of town last year and missed it. Welcome to all guests and visitors who are worshipping with us this weekend. We are glad you are here with us.

There seems to be something going around the community at this time. I have visited many folks who are not feeling well, some for quite a while. If you know of anyone who would like the anointing of the sick or a prayer prayed with and/or for them, please let me know. The power of prayer is real.

The Passe Scholarship is now open for those in post-secondary education for this upcoming year of 2026-27. This scholarship is for students and parishioners from Kellogg, Wabasha, and Conception parishes. I sit on the committee that makes the grants of money to those who have applied. There is a large amount of funds to be dispersed, and I would recommend anyone eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Our Gospel for the Second Sunday of Lent is from Matthew 17:1-9. This Gospel passage has been referred to as the Transfiguration, where Jesus' face shone like the sun and his clothes became dazzling white. The Gospel writer is giving us an idea of who Jesus is and will be. The prophets Moses and Elijah appear to connect Jesus to the law and the prophets. If we look at the words that God spoke, they are the same words that God spoke at the baptism of Jesus. I find the most powerful part of this Gospel is when Jesus tells Peter that we have to go back down the mountain, we can't stay here forever. The journey of speaking and spreading the Good News has to keep happening. Plus, Jesus has to continue his journey to the Cross in Jerusalem. During Lent are we willing to follow Jesus when times are good but also, maybe when times aren't so good? I invite us to pray for all who are struggling on their faith journey.
