The Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary in Winona is back from Spring Break. I will be going to the seminary every other Thursday to be a Spiritual Director for four of the young men studying for the priesthood. I have been doing this for a number of years and am impressed with the young men looking into the priesthood. I would ask for your continued prayers for me and all those at IHM seminary.

Please note that there is Communal Reconciliation for those interested, March 15th at Lake City and March 22nd at Plainview. Both services start at 3:30 PM and we'll have at least three priests present to hear confessions. I'll be in Kellogg on March 22nd from 1-2 PM Sunday afternoon to hear confessions. I know some folks like to venture out in the afternoon in the daylight and avoid driving in the dark. I will continue to hear confessions on Thursdays in Wabasha from 5:30 - 6:30 PM. Come and enjoy the forgiveness and freedom that only Jesus can offer you. It will be worth the effort.

As we gather to celebrate the Eucharist this weekend, we continue to hear from the Gospel of John 9:1-41. This is the longer version of the gospel, and there is also a shorter version to be proclaimed at Mass. Keep in mind that this gospel is to be used when the parish has people preparing to be baptized and join the church. This gospels' also assigned to this year as part of the three-year cycle of readings. The gospel today involves a man born blind and how he was healed by Jesus. Notice the many layers and attitudes of the people we meet in the gospel - the Pharisees, man born blind, the parents of the man, the crowd and Jesus himself. What becomes of the healing of the blind man is the beautiful sense of moving from darkness into the light, not only physical light but especially the light of faith. When we are aware of the presence of Jesus in our lives are we open to receiving the gift of light, not only physically but especially when it involves the light of faith.
