FR. TOM LOOMIS PASTOR

I am excited to share with you that we will be entering into a feasibility study at St. Felix concerning raising money for the building and renovation projects at St. Felix Church and school. We hired a consultant, Kim Snyder from the Excelsior Bay Group; she will be spearheading the feasibility study. She has been very easy to work with, and Kim has been working in the area of planning and fundraising for many years. Please know that Kim may be reaching out to a number of parishioners by phone to get a sense on how quickly we can move ahead with the projects and finances. The current Building and Renovation Committee has put in much work over the past number of months to get us to this point. I realize we have been talking about building and renovation for a while now, and I feel it's time to take the next step in this process and journey. I ask your prayers as we listen intently to the Holy Spirit in order to get a sense of what is being asked of us, and how we open ourselves to an amazing present and future as we give thanks for those in the past who helped build our church and school.

On this Fifth Sunday of Lent, we will hear once again for the Gospel of John 11:1-454. Keep in mind that this is the third Gospel in a row that is used when people are joining the Catholic Church. As you hear this Gospel proclaimed this weekend, ask yourself, why would those looking to join the church need to hear this Gospel. It is about a man named Lazarus who had died. We again see how the reactions of all in the Gospel tell us something about the community and their beliefs. Jesus is the one who can grant eternal life, and he has gifted us with eternal life through his life, death and resurrection. Where do we find ourself in this story about Lazarus? Do we accept the gift of life that Jesus has given us or are we full of doubts that lead us away from him?

We also love going to the river to watch for boats and eagles, and go on scavenger hunts around town. We have all heard the saying "it takes a village to raise a child". Our preschoolers start their day in prayer with the whole school, and spend time each week with our 3rd grade buddies. We have people come into our classroom and teach us about fire safety, how to make special Christmas treats, and how to quilt. Our preschoolers at St. Felix are blessed to have a wonderful, caring village to help raise them.
