I enjoyed our liturgies at St. Felix and St. Agnes and it was nice to see the faith so alive during the Triduum and Easter Sunday. It's a powerful sign and reminder that there is something in all of us that desires to know God. There is that place within all of us that can only be filled by God. When we allow God to fill our hearts, even for a moment, we have a deeper sense of who we are and how we are called to live in this world, preparing for the eternal life to come. As we continue our Easter journey of 50 days, we open ourselves up to the presence of Jesus among us. I realize that this can seem very difficult at times because of what life can send our way. I invite all of us during this Easter season to worship together in community as we gather as a Resurrection people.

Thank you to everyone who had a role in helping us participate in the beautiful liturgies during Holy Week. The decorating was beautiful, the music was uplifting, the ministries (lector, serving, reader, etc.) were reverent. Thank you to Heather for keeping all the details straight (not a gift of mine). Thank you to everyone who worked behind the scenes.

The Sunday after Easter is known as Divine Mercy Sunday. We will hear from the Gospel of John 20:19-31. We meet Thomas who was not present when Jesus first appeared to the disciples as they hid in fear. Thomas is present when Jesus appears a second time. Jesus invites Thomas to put his fingers in the nail marks and Thomas does. Thomas exclaims, "My Lord and my God". Today, like the apostles, we may be living in fear. Jesus assures us that he is present among us and has already given us the gift of the Holy Spirit. Sometime during this week, I invite us to say the prayer of Thomas - My Lord and my God!
