Our Scripture readings for Palm Sunday and Holy Week are amazing stories and invitations to new life. The Word of God will take us deep into ourselves but also deep into what it means to be a community of faith. We will hear the story of the Passion of Jesus twice this week, once on Palm Sunday and again on Good Friday.

The word Passion is such a strong word and if we take a moment to reflect on the word Passion we realize that it is full of feeling and emotion. Are we willing to enter into the Heart of Jesus with a desire to unite our pain with Him? Are we willing to feel, pray about, think about what it means to be human with everything that goes along with it? How many times have we felt like I don't want to do something but it needs to be done and I sacrifice to make sure it happens? Maybe your presence at Holy Week liturgies is something you are being called to be part of to deepen your faith. Once again, I invite you to pray for this community. What is that we are being called to by Jesus?

As we begin our Holy Week journey with our celebration of the Eucharist and Palm Sunday, we realize we are invited to walk with one another as a community of faith. What are we hoping to receive from Jesus this week? Are we longing for a deeper relationship with Jesus? Sometimes for that to happen, we need to make changes in our lives and our routines to have a new openness to the presence of Jesus in our lives. Holy Week offers us an opportunity "to take the next step" in faith lives.

Again, I invite you to consider attending all the liturgies during this Holy Week beginning with Holy Thursday. It will make sense to you why we celebrate and gather the way we do as Catholics. Our Traditions and prayer are very beautiful and full of life. I invite you to come and check it out. You will not be disappointed'

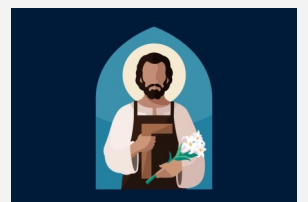
