**FR. TOM LOOMIS  
PASTOR**

I'm trying to be mindful to be present to Jesus during these fifty days of Easter. The Acts of the Apostles is such a great way to follow the beginnings of the church during these next weeks. Most of the first readings for the weekend and daily Masses will come from the Acts of the Apostles. It's the church's way of helping those who are new to the church to get a deeper understanding of how Jesus is alive in the worshipping community. It is also a powerful reminder for those of who have been in the church for a long time about who we are with Jesus at our center. Please keep one another in prayer during this sometimes beautiful, but also at times chaotic, time in our world and community.

As we celebrate the Third Sunday of Easter, we will hear a powerful story proclaimed from the Gospel of Luke 24:13-35. It is about the Road to Emmaus. When I think of Jesus sharing the Scriptures with those on the Road to Emmaus, I can imagine how their "hearts were on fire" as they listened to him. One important detail of this story is the detail that they invited Jesus to stay with them. By inviting him to stay, eventually their eyes (not only physical eyes but spiritual eyes) were opened as they recognized him in the breaking of the bread. As we pray together this weekend and "break bread" in the Eucharist I invite us to pray for ourselves and each other that our "eyes are opened" as we recognize Jesus in the breaking of the bread.
