We celebrate First Communion with 11 of our young people this weekend at St. Felix and St. Agnes. I am often amazed at the faith of our children. It reminds me of the childlike faith that Jesus speaks about in the Gospels. There is still an innocence that exists in our children that allows them to not be so negatively affected by the world....yet. For many of us adults we can become hardened or cynical when it comes to faith, Jesus, church, etc. I invite you to observe our children when they receive the Eucharist for the first time this weekend. What are you going to see? My guess is children who are filled with joy and excitement. As a community of faith, I invite us to validate our children's experience of receiving the Eucharist on their First Communion day. Let's be excited for them, that they are able to receive such a great gift. Hopefully the Spirit will flow through them into us, the larger worshipping community.

We gather this weekend to pray and worship on this Fourth Sunday of Easter. The Gospel will be proclaimed from John 10: 1-10. This Gospel sets us up for next week's Gospel where Jesus calls himself the Good Shepherd. Today's Gospel shows us that Jesus, as the shepherd, both protects us and feeds us. He is the gate where the sheep enter. Someone who has bad intentions will climb over the fence to steal but Jesus is at the entrance to protect. The sheep recognize his voice and will follow him. There are so many different voices calling to us constantly in this world. As we gather in this church this weekend are we willing to give our attention to the one voice that matters, the voice of Jesus.

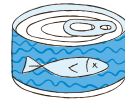
