Father Tom Loomis Pastor

I appreciate and am very thankful for your presence and prayers at our Holy Week celebrations. It was amazing to come together and pray like we did. The Spirit is alive and it was lifegiving to experience the gift of the Holy within us and among us. I am also very grateful for all of those who extended a helping hand with decorating, music, ministries and Easter Vigil fire preparation. It is powerful when we gather in the name of Jesus and pray and work together as the Body of Christ. There is a freedom and joy that only Jesus can offer us and I pray that we had that sense and belief as we came together during our Holy Week.

We continue to pray for Pope Francis after his death. There are many opinions on his time as Pope but for me he was a great inspiration. His sense of being a pastor touched me deeply. He was able to see and to know those on the fringes, which many times can make those in the inner circle a bit uncomfortable. I am hopeful that we as pastors and people of faith take his statement to "smell like the sheep" seriously. We have to reach out and be present to those who are struggling, even if it makes us uncomfortable. May he rest in peace.

This weekend we celebrate the Second Sunday of Easter also known as Divine Mercy Sunday. Our Gospel comes from John's 20th chapter, verses 19-31. We hear about Thomas who won't believe that Jesus rose from the dead until he sees him and can touch him. Thomas gets the title of doubting Thomas which is far from the reality. It seems to me you can't doubt unless you have faith in the first place. After seeing Jeus and touching Jesus, Thomas makes one of the greatest statements of faith in the Scriptures when he proclaims, "My Lord and my God"! As we continue the celebration of Easter for the next many days until Pentecost, like Thomas may we be able to proclaim, My Lord and my God!




