I pray that you all have a happy and holy Easter day and season. There is something alive in this community during Easter. The Holy Spirit is opening us up to the reality of a Risen Jesus who has and can make a difference in our lives, here on earth, but also, eternally. I appreciate that we can gather to celebrate the Eucharist and at least for a few moments to really believe we can live the way Jesus invites us to live. For some reason, many of us struggle with that invitation to follow Jesus. Many things in this world can pull us away from our journey with Jesus. From the beginning of the church, the struggle has been real. The Resurrection and the gift of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost changed everything. I invite us, as a community, to be a people of Easter, celebrating the Resurrection and new life that is offered to us on this day and at this time.

Our Gospel reading for this Easter Sunday comes from John 20:1-9. Mary Magdala comes to the tomb while it is still dark. The stone of the tomb was removed, and she ran to get Peter. As John and Peter entered the tomb, they saw and believed. Our Gospel ends with the notion that they did not yet understand the Scriptures that Jesus had to rise from the dead. This description of the scene at the tomb reminds us that even the disciples couldn't wrap their minds and hearts around what it meant to rise from the dead. I think many of us have those same questions and sometimes the struggle of believing that we are loved and saved by Jesus. I invite us to ponder this during the next 50 days of the Easter Season. Could this be the time in our lives where the reality of Jesus becomes alive for us?
