We will soon celebrate Holy Week. The week begins with our celebration of Palm Sunday. We will celebrate the Triduum (three days) on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil. I want to invite you to seriously consider attending the Triduum. The three days are one liturgy.

On Holy Thursday we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist and Priesthood and being a servant to God's people. We come together on Good Friday to honor the death of Jesus and the Easter Vigil is preparing us for the Resurrection. After the Holy Thursday Mass there is no final blessing as we pick up our prayer on Good Friday and start right into our prayer. We leave Good Friday without a final blessing because we gather at the Vigil and bring the three days of prayer to a conclusion. The three days are a beautiful way to pray and journey together as the Universal Church. Please consider joining us for all the liturgies. I know you will not be disappointed.

As we gather around the Altar of life this weekend we hear from John 8:1-11. It tells a story of a woman caught in adultery (we don't hear about the man). The law says to stone her to death. Jesus says otherwise. The one who has no sin may cast the first stone. They walked away in silence beginning with the elders - the ones who heard with their hearts what Jesus said. What a powerful story about judgement, forgiveness and a change of heart. We know the story well in our own lives. Many have had an experience of being judged or being the judge. We are all asked to change our hearts as we go and sin no more.
