All parishioners are encouraged to join us for this celebration of our Lord's Presence in the Eucharist, and to pray for our parishes and school.



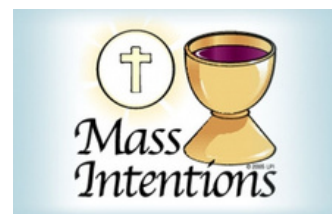

St Felix Church 3rd Street Door Project

The church's front doors on 3rd Street are being refinished with new electronic locks this summer. The exterior vestibule is being sanded and repainted. The project is funded in the current 2025-2026 improvement budget. The existing solid wood doors are being preserved and most of the brass hardware reused. New electronic security features will replace the faulty locks and keys with fobs like are used at St Felix school and auditorium. The door closers will be readjusted or replaced. The project will start the week of May 25th and finish by July 17th.

Watch for weekly updates as temporary doors are installed and painting work starts. You may address questions to Buck Gosse or Dan Schaefer.
