

JUNE 19TH SOCIAL CONCERNS REPORT

- Pope Leo XIV's name and papacy were reviewed; his commitment to social justice is modeled on predecessor Leo XIII whose 1891 encyclical Rerum Novarum promoted justice in the workplace.
- An outcome of the May 7 Gathering of Local Aid Organizations will be a brochure available to the public, listing services and contact information for those in need.
- Adult/youth volunteers are needed to join St. Felix Social Concerns Committee members for Feed My Starving Children's food packaging at Christ Church in Plainview on August 22. Contact John Hampe (651) 565-2350 or jshampe@gmail.com.
- Isaac Landsteiner, Diocesan Director of Parish Social Ministry, will be invited to give a parish talk on The Eucharist and Catholic Social Teaching, sometime in late September; after 9:30 Sunday Mass with hospitality provided.
- Immigration is an issue that national governments are not adequately dealing with, not just in the U.S. but globally, caused by climate and upheaval. The U.S. bishops request a humane way to deal with this challenge, ensuring dignified treatment as brothers and sisters.
- •The U.S. bishops sent a 9-point letter to Congress on the One Big Beautiful Bill before Congress addressing both positive and harmful aspects of the bill, calling to protect the vulnerable.
