Summer is off to a strong start. As of the writing of the column (Tuesday) we are in need of rain in the area and I'm praying it has rained as you are reading this column. This past Friday we Ordained three men to the priesthood for the diocese of Winona - Rochester. We have had nine ordinations to the priesthood over the past three years and have seen a great spirit among the priests of the diocese as a whole. The newly ordained are helping in many communities, including parishes, schools and Newman Centers. We are a grateful diocese and continue to invite men and women to consider a vocation to the priesthood or religious life.

As we gather to pray the Eucharist this weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Our Gospel comes from John 6:51-58. Jesus is explaining that we must "eat his body and drink his blood" and the people begin to quarrel among themselves. Jesus does not soften his words or back off. Instead, he doubles down by saying "whoever eats and drinks lives forever". In the Catholic Church the Eucharist (Body and Blood of Jesus) is central to our belief and understanding of Jesus. We call the Eucharist, The Source and Summit" of our lives. Like many in our Gospel today, this is a hard teaching to accept.

Are we willing to accept the truth of the words of Jesus today about his Body and Blood? How do we live this gift in life on a daily basis?

Social Concerns Committee Minutes

May 21, 2026

- Opening Prayer-Jesus's prayer for his disciples
- The March Minutes were approved.
- Food Shelf basket in church-Sandra Allaire and Jane Timm reported that donations for tuna and salmon excellent, and taken to the Food Shelf. It will stop a week after Pentecost to continue again afterward; given the cost of gas, aid will also be requested in the Sunday bulletin, in the form of gas cards or donations for that purpose to the Charity Fund.
- The 2026 Earth Day pilgrimage at Hok Si La Park-Thanks to Kris Kruse for commentary on plants and trees; the event will be held again in April 2027; participation will extend to all Wabasha churches;
- Other local events were mentioned: Frontenac State Park Quilt exhibit, June 13, 10 am-5 pm, Wabasha Library June 14 Native American themed presentation on "The Seed Keeper".
- Planning for a fall pilgrimage to Mankato Native American Memorial was approved; it could include a visit to Blue Earth County Museum.
- An award to the parish KCs for their participation in the plastic free pledge was approved. It will be awarded during an upcoming weekend Mass.
- May 25th encyclical on A.I.; current legislation and Supreme Court decisions on voting rights and a quote on racism from the USCCB's 2018 "Open Wide Our Hearts" document; the state-sanctioned encroachment on Palestinian land in Israel; recent federal relaxation of farm uses of diesel fuel and pesticides; Pope Leo's record on environment after a year in office.
- A recent offer of a sister parish in Guinea, Africa, was discussed; the unanimous agreement was to pass on the offer, for several reasons conveyed to Father Loomis.
- The next meeting will be July 23, 2026
- The Closing Prayer was to the Holy Spirit for Pentecost
